## **Shaving Cream**

Use Shaving Cream and Ink refills to create fun backgrounds with a tie-dye look.



## **Supplies**

**Shaving Cream** 


Classic Ink refills in two to three colors

Straw or stick for mixing

Straight edged tool

**Paper towels or tissues** 

Flat tray or pan



Spray shaving cream in a rectangular pattern a little larger than the size of your cardstock



Add drops of ink in two to three colors randomly, over the shaving cream

For more color coverage, place the drops closer together. For less coverage, space the drops further apart.



Use a straw or dowel to swirl and blend the ink through the shaving cream into the desired pattern

Over-blending will cause your colors to muddy



Press your cardstock into the shaving cream to get good color coverage

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Remove Cardstock from shaving cream and place messy side up on scrap paper



Place another piece of card stock on top of the first piece and press into the shaving cream to get a second patterned background

You can repeat this process two or three times for additional pieces from the same ink

Keep some on hand for quick cards when you need them



Scrape the shaving cream from the card stock using a baker's scraper or other flat edged tool



Use a paper towel to wipe away all of the excess shaving cream



Each piece of card stock will have a different look



Layer an image on top or stamp directly onto your background paper

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
